
As we enter a new year, I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your service to the Town of Palm Beach.

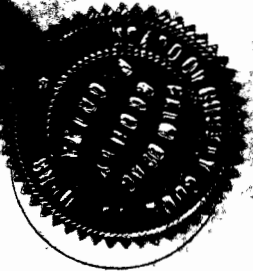

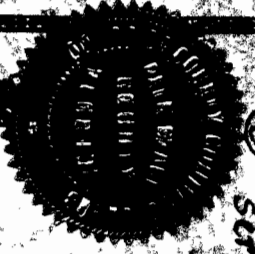
